

HISTORIC COLUMBIA FOUNDATION

Purpose(s)/Service(s): By agreement dated December 6, 1994, County Council contracted with the Foundation for operation and management of the historic properties known as the Museum of Reconstruction Era at the Woodrow Wilson Family Home and the Hampton-Preston Mansion.

During the existence of the agreement, the County Council will designate **TWO (2)** representatives, with **FOUR (4)** year terms, to serve on the Foundation Board of Trustees, in compliance with Foundation by-laws. Members shall not serve more than **TWO (2)** consecutive terms; however, upon service of **TWO (2)** consecutive terms a member may be eligible for reappointment after **ONE (1)** year on non-service.

Meetings are held the 4th Monday every other month beginning in January from 4:00-5:30 PM. Members are required to attend board orientation (1 ½ hour), a board retreat (5-6 hours), and the annual meeting (2 hours).

Board members are requested to:

- Commit to participate in the ongoing cultivation of community support and to actively participate in fundraising;
- Make a financial contribution and maintain an individual membership while serving on the Board;
- Attend 3-5 Historic Columbia events each year;
- Attend at least one County Council meeting each year; and
- Participate in at least **ONE (1)** volunteer activity per year.
