1. **CALL TO ORDER** - Ms. Newton called the meeting to order at approximately 4:00 PM

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a. May 7, 2019 Mr. Malinowski moved, seconded by Ms. Newton, to approve the minutes as distributed. The vote in favor was unanimous.
- 3. <u>ADOPTION OF AGENDA</u> Mr. Malinowski stated that a vacancy on the Airport Commission needed to be added to the agenda as Item 4(a)(15).

Mr. Malinowski moved, seconded by Ms. Newton, to adopt the agenda as amended. The vote in favor was unanimous.

The vote in favor was unanimous.
- b. I move that we establish rules for electing persons to serve on Boards/Commissions rather than going by the Parliamentarian's recollections of how it was done in the past with serious consideration to include appointments require a majority of Council members' vote [MANNING] Mr. Malinowski moved, seconded by Ms. Kennedy, to direct Mr. Farrar to bring back recommended changes to Council Rules at the June 4th committee meeting. The vote in favor was unanimous.
