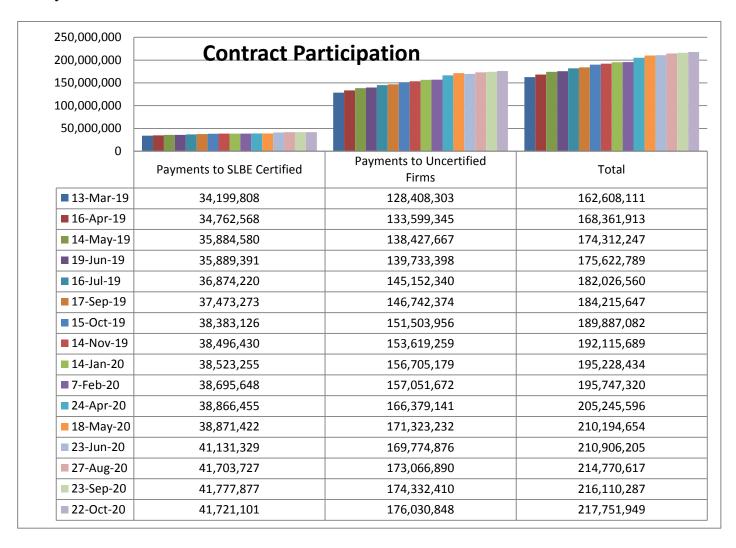

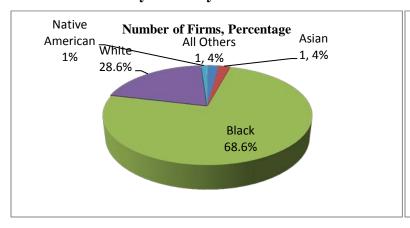

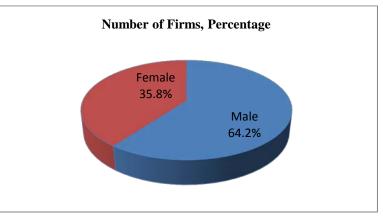

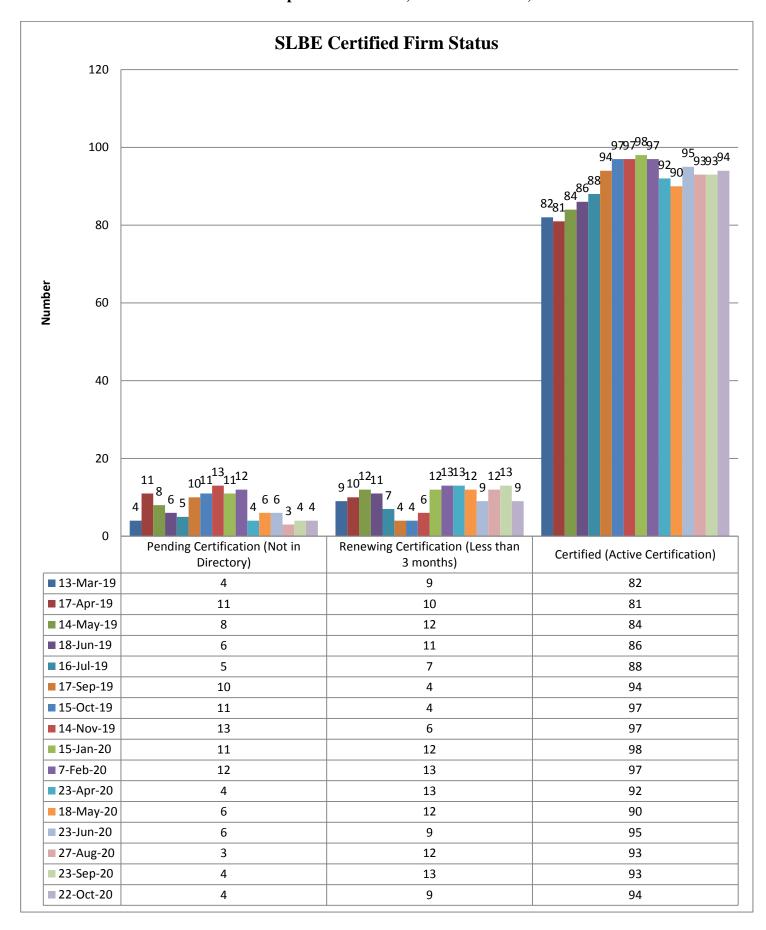
#### **SLBE Firms by Ethnicity**

#### **Transportation Update- October 26, 2020**

#### **Council Approvals**

- The Polo Road Widening Service Order (SO) was approved on October 6, 2020. This service order covers the 100% design, permitting, and construction phase services for the Polo Rd. Widening Project, which includes improvements at the intersections of Running Fox Rd., Miles Rd., Hope Rd., and Mallet Hill Rd. The intersection at Old Still Rd. will also be evaluated to determine if improvements are warranted there as well. This project also includes bike and pedestrian accommodations between Two Notch Rd. and Mallet Hill Dr.
- An annexation petition went before Council on October 20 for second reading. The
  petition for annexation by the City of Columbia is for two (2) parcels (TMS#07208-0301 and TMS#07208-03-02), acquired by the County in 2016 to secure the property
  needed to complete Three Rivers Greenway Phase 1A.
- Council approved third reading of a deed to transfer a utility waterline to the City of Columbia as part of the Clemson Road widening project.
- Council approved the sale of Mitigation Bank Credits to Weyerhaeuser NR Company for the I-26 Interchange Widening Project.
- A new Finance Manager-Transportation position was approved. The Department is in the process of finalizing the required paperwork to create the position.
- Pending Approval: Spears Creek Church Road Widening Service Order and new department organizational chart

#### **Pre-Construction Update**

- A service order to perform final design work on the Gills Creek Greenway project is being drafted.
- A service order to perform final design work for the Crane Creek Greenway Section B
  is being drafted This project will consist of approximately four thousand eight-hundred
  and ninety-five (4,895) LF of boardwalk from Canal Front Park and will end at S-798
  (Mountain Drive).

#### **Construction Update**

 North Springs/ Harrington Intersection: NTP issued on 2/3/2020 and construction began February 2020. Anticipated completion is October 2020. Construction is 95%

- complete. Punchlist items remain.
- <u>Polo Road SUP</u>- The project began in April and is progressing. Anticipate completion in early 2021.
- Harrison Road Sidewalk- Construction is approximately 50% complete. The County approved the realignment of 714 feet of the 1.2-mile sidewalk in order to address drainage problems. Anticipate completion in early 2021.
- Greene Street Ph. II- Construction is approximately 17% complete. Utilities continue to be relocated and storm drainage installation is in progress. Began bent 3 and crash wall installation on bridge. Overhead utilities removed. Began installing formwork for cap, walls and walkway at bent 3.
- Clemson Road Widening- Construction is 75% complete and on schedule for an early winter 2021 completion date. Concrete sidewalk/shared use paths and concrete curb and gutter installed along Clemson Road from Old Clemson Road towards Earth Road completed on the right side. Completion on the left side is underway. Traffic Pattern change along Clemson Road from Old Clemson Road towards Earth Road due to asphalt paving of new left and right lanes. Traffic Signal Installation at the Clemson Road and Earth Road intersection
- North Main Street Project is approximately 84% complete and on track for an early winter 2021 completion data. Construction continues on road, drainage, sidewalk and street lighting. Curb installed from Sunset to Monticello, light poles are nearly complete in Ph. II and III, concrete median and landscaping is underway.
- <u>Three Rivers Greenway</u> Project is 99% compete. Waiting on final as-built surveys.
   Developing the change order to issue to the contractor for the Boyd Island Connector segment (1B).
- <u>Magnolia/Schoolhouse Sidewalks</u> Construction is complete. Remaining drainage improvements are underway on Magnolia.
- <u>Dirt Road Package J</u>- All paving is complete. Drainage issue on Haven Circle resolved. Final inspection completed
- <u>Candlewood NIP Phase 3</u> Complete
- <u>SERN</u> Construction is approximately 67% complete. Garners Ferry Road Traffic pattern changed, Garners Ferry Road drainage structures installed, Rabbit Run Road Connector stone base placement, and preparing for asphalt surface. Projected completion is early winter 2021.

- Resurfacing P (80 roads) Construction is complete. Project is in closeout.
- Resurfacing Package Q- Project is substantially complete. Roads paved totals 46. The
  Contractor will completed the resurface of Decker Blvd to the stop bar at the
  intersection of Decker Blvd and Percival Road. County is scheduling a final inspection
  with the Contractor to close the project out.
